The South Australian Government announced today that South Australia is going into a hard lockdown as of midnight 18th November 2020 for the next 6 days.

The South Australian Produce Market is considered an essential service and will remain open to supply the fresh fruit and vegetable retailer sector. Green Grocers are also an essential service under the definition of fresh fruit retail.

We strongly recommend that market users carry with them an essential services letter at all times. An example of this letter is attached. It will need to be modified to suit your business and must be on your company letterhead.

This is what the lockdown means for the Market:

- Wearing of masks for the next 6 days is now a government requirement and everyone on site must wear a mask at all times. Anyone not wearing a mask will be removed from the Market and reported to Police;
- Retailers are **not permitted** to walk the floor for the next 6 days. Wholesalers and growers will need to deliver to your vehicle only;
- Cash and Carry access times will be in place for the next 6 days;
- There will be no Café or catering on site for the next 6 days; and
- It is up to your employer to provide you with the correct PPE (ie. masks) and hand sanitizer.

If you have any symptoms **DO NOT** come to the market, this will have serious implications if COVID19 is detected on this site.

SAPML COVID marshals will be enforcing these rules to the letter of the directive. It is up to us all to follow these rules so that we can remain open and provide these essential services to South Australia.

To avoid delays and frustration please use both the front and rear entry gates. With temperature testing occurring for all market patrons there will be some delay in accessing the site. Please be patient.
