URGENT PLEASE REPLY FOR YOUR INFORMATION PLEASE REVIEW

SA Health has issued a COVID-19 Health Alert for City of Brisbane, Logan City, City of Ipswich, Moreton Bay Region and Redland City.

**Effective 5pm 29 MARCH 2021,
City of Brisbane, Logan City, City of Ipswich, Moreton Bay Region
and Redland City are now prohibited zones.
People who have been in City of Brisbane, Logan City, City of
Ipswich, Moreton Bay Region and Redland City will not be permitted
entry into South Australia.**

Travellers who arrived in South Australia between 20 March 2021 and before 5:00 pm 29 March 2021 from the City of Brisbane, Logan City, City of Ipswich, Moreton Bay Region and Redland City, must:

- submit to COVID-19 testing on day 1, 5 and 13.
- must comply with the self-quarantine requirements until they get a negative COVID-19 test result.
- not enter or remain in a high risk setting in South Australia for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia or until they get a negative COVID-19 test result unless the person is permitted to enter under Clause 9 in the Emergency Management (Cross Border Travel—General) (COVID-19) Direction 2021.
- not attend any event in South Australia with an approved COVID -19 Management Plan or at which more than 1000 people are present for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.

Effective from 5:00 pm 29 March 2021

People from the Brisbane, Logan, Ipswich, Moreton Bay and Redlands areas are prohibited from entering South Australia unless they are returning South Australian Residents / Genuine relocations / Domestic Violence victims) or Essential Travellers.

Note: These people are required to self-quarantine for 14 days (when not working), submit to a COVID-19 test on day 1, 5 and 13 and wear a mask in public. Refer to table on next page.

Arrivals between 12:01 am 20 March and 5:00 pm 29 March 2021	Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine until negative test. No entry to high risk setting until negative test. No entry to COVID Management Plan events <1000.
Returning SA Residents, Genuine Relocations or Domestic Violence victims entering SA after 5:00 pm 29 March 2021	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Must self-quarantine 14 days. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
Travellers arriving from Queensland restricted zone after 5:00 pm 29 March 2021	Level 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not permitted to enter South Australia.
Category 1 Essential Travellers from Queensland restricted zone	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Not required to Self-quarantine. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia. Must not enter or remain in a high risk setting in South Australia for a period of 14 days after their arrival.
Category 2 Essential Travellers from Queensland restricted zone	Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Self-quarantine unless performing the duties, functions or activities of the category, travelling to and from performing the duties, functions or activities, or passing through. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
Category 1 and 2 Essential Travellers from Overseas	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine as directed. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.
All overseas arrivals (other than New Zealand arrivals)	Level 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> COVID-19 test on day 1, 5, & 13. Quarantine as directed. Must wear a face mask (covering mouth and nose) at any time that they come into contact with the public for a period of 14 days after their arrival in South Australia.

Queensland restricted zone: City of Brisbane, City of Ipswich, Logan City, Moreton Bay Region, and Redland City.

Category 1 Essential Travellers: National and State security and governance, Emergency services workers, Commercial transport and freight services, Remote or isolated workers who travel to restricted or prohibited zone locations, and Cross border community members.

Category 2 Essential Travellers: National and State security and governance—restricted or prohibited zone residents, Specialist workers in essential sectors, Commercial transport and freight services—restricted or prohibited zone residents, Remote or isolated workers—restricted or prohibited zone residents, Passing through, Foreign diplomatic or consular staff.
